Being ready for school	Ask that our uniform is worn and the policy on jewellery is followed.	Send my child to school wearing appropriate uniform and jewellery. Make sure my child is prepared for school with the correct kit and equipment.	Wear my uniform and not wear more jewellery than plain studs or a watch. Bring my PE kit and other equipment on the right days.
Attendance and punctuality	Actively encourage and reward good attendance and punctuality. Follow up all absences, including term-time holidays. Support you if you are having difficulties in getting your child to school.	Ensure my child attends school unless they are too ill to do so. Trust the school to let me know if my child is poorly or hurt. Follow the school policy on term-time leave requests.	Come to school every day and arrive in good time for the start of lessons.
Class and homework	Plan and teach all aspects of the National Curriculum to meet the needs of your child. Mark work so your child knows how to improve. Communicate regularly about homework.	Take an interest in my child's work at school, encouraging them to do their best. Talk to teachers if there are any problems or successes at home. Make sure homework is completed.	Listen carefully. Do my best. Know my targets and work hard to achieve them. Do my homework.
Behaviour	Have high expectations of behaviour at all times, in and out of the classroom. Inform you immediately of any problems.	Encourage my child to follow the rules and behave well. Support the school's high expectations of behaviour.	Do the right thing and behave well at school, on the way to school and on the way home. Follow the school rules.
Pastoral Support	Listen and respond quickly to any concerns or problems. Give help and support to you, your child or your family wherever possible.	Let the school know quickly if there is anything that is affecting my child's learning or behaviour.	Let a grown up know if I am worried or have a problem so they can help me to sort it out.
Links with school	Hold regular parents' evenings. Report regularly on progress, behaviour and attendance. Inform you of any concerns or problems at school.	Attend parents' evenings (or make other arrangements if I can't). Read school letters and reply in good time. Support the school in helping my child to achieve.	Make sure I take letters home and hand them over.
Extra-curricular activities and events	Organise a range of clubs and events for your child, in and out of school time. Organise productions, events and assemblies to which you will be invited.	Encourage my child to attend after-school clubs in order to learn new skills and stay active. Support school teams! Come to the events if I can.	Find out what clubs are on that I might want to join. Make sure that if I join a club I attend regularly and try not to miss one.
Internet Safety	Teach the children how to use the internet safely and responsibly following guidelines from www.kidsmart.org.uk	Go through the Acceptable Use Policy with my child and make sure they understand how to use the internet responsibly. I will return a signed copy to school.	Use the internet safely and sensibly in line with the SMART rules.
