EASTER MENU – HOPPY EASTER

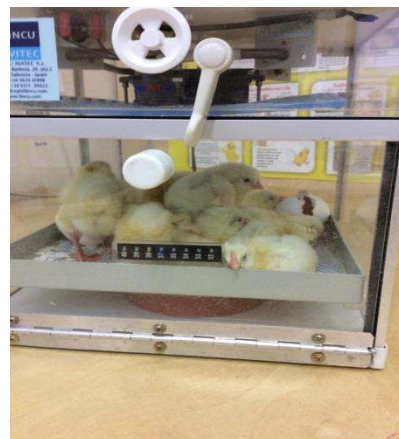
