TASKS	Need some support? Here are some ideas that may help you. Remember, you do not need to follow these. You might have better ideas, or want to focus on one aspect only.	
Number	Can you identify one more and one less than a given number using a number line. Perhaps you could make your own number line outside with chalk etc. get your grown up to take photos or make notes about what you did.	
Writing	Write three sentences describing what you like about spring, try to use the word because.	
Speaking	Get your adult to video you or record you talking about the changes you have seen from winter to spring.	
School Values - Hope	Talk to your adults about what you hope to get better at in school this term.	
Traditional Tales	Draw a story map of your favourite traditional tale and write a sentence about your favourite part.	
Nursery rhymes	Practise the nursery rhymes: Twinkle Twinkle, 5 Little Monkeys, Humpty Dumpty, Baa Baa black sheep, Jack and Jill, Row Row Row your boat, The Wheels on the Bus, Old McDonald, Grand Old Duke of York, Hickory Dickory Dock, Incy Wincy Spider, Pat a cake pat a cake, 1, 2 buckle my shoe, Polly put the kettle on, Three blind mice. If you can perform 5 or 10 of these rhymes you will receive a certificate. If you can perform all 15 you will receive a prize.
