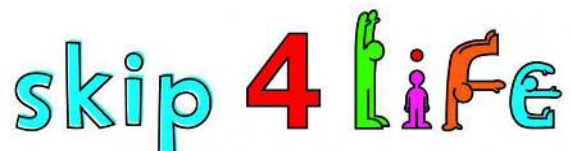
At the end of the day, school gates open at 3.10pm with some seating and space outside if you arrive early. The school office is not available as a waiting space at the end of the day.
