


Home Learning Tasks Autumn 2 2018 Which six will YOU choose? Reception		
TASKS	Need some support? Here are some ideas that may help you. Remember, you do not need to follow these. You might have better ideas, or want to focus on one aspect only.	
Reading	<i>What is your favourite story? Can you draw a story map to show what happens in the correct order? You might want to add some words to label your pictures.</i>	
Writing	<i>Can you write labels for these pictures? Remember to sound the word out on your fingers and start each letter from the top.</i>	
Numbers	<i>Can you make a number line from 0 to 10 or even to 20? Once you have made the number line, line up the correct amount of objects under each number!</i>	
Measuring	<i>Can you find 3 different items and put them in order of length? Maybe you could use a measuring tape to find how long they are as well?</i>	
Speaking	<i>Can you talk about your favourite toy? Have a think about what you like about it and the games you play and then talk about it to a grown up. Remember to speak in full sentences and answer any questions they ask you. We would love to see some videos on Tapestry!</i>	
Christmas	<i>Do you celebrate Christmas? What traditions do you have in your house? Write, draw or take photos and we will compare the similarities and differences with the other children in Reception!</i>	
Creative	<i>We were amazed by your Halloween decorations! Could you make a Christmas decoration too? You can bring it to school before Christmas to decorate the classroom or take a photo of it up in your house during the holidays!</i>	
Other Learning	<i>What else have you been learning at home?</i>
