SCHOOL EXTENSION WORK

The building work began in the summer holidays, to add 2 new classrooms to the end of the heart and is on track to be complete in January 2019. Work will begin shortly on the site next to school, to extend the school playing field provision and should also be ready for January. In the meantime we will work with the building contractors to minimise disruption to the school. Access will be busy during this time, as we can only use one side of the building.
