TASKS	These tasks are linked to your child's learning journey at school. If you do any other work please feel free to share it.	
Spellings and reading Weekly practice – extra to the six.	Please practice your spellings- it could be in your home learning book – maybe even find their meanings or write them in a sentence. Read 4 times at least a week and record it in your reading diary.	
Maths	We will be looking at shape, time and data handling. We will also look at various problem solving activities.	
Literacy	Find out about a British Inventor. Present the information as a biography. You may need to research this area carefully.	
Topic	Research different British Inventors. Draw or write about them? What are they famous for?	
Science	Why is electricity so important to us? Can you produce a poster explaining what electricity is?	
Art/DT	Find out about different mechanisms. Can you draw a specific one? How does it work? What is it used for?	
PE	Go for a walk with your family. What did you see? What kind of buildings did you encounter? Map your walk out.	
Computing	Make a PowerPoint or word document about any of our topics this term and email it to admin or print out the slides and stick it in your home learning book.	
Other learning	Take a look at the year group expectations given out at parents evening – work on something you are struggling to do and master it. Show resilience!
